# Frequently Asked Questions

#### **TUSCANY-WB-K Pergola**

## What is the pergola made out of?

The pergola is made from glass fiber reinforced concrete columns and salvaged Ponderosa Pine beams. The pergola is styled in a classic column-and-beam arbor design with a dark stained wood and stone finish.

# Will the pergola withstand extreme weather conditions?

The pergola is weatherproof and designed to withstand most weather conditions. The heavy-duty beams are supported by four 135-lb columns for stability. The powder coated and zinc plated hardware are designed to prevent rust in most environments.

# Can the pergola be secured to the ground?

Yes, it must be securely fastened by drilling through the columns. They must be secured per the instructions for stability.

#### Do the columns or beams come in different sizes or colors?

The columns are available as stand-alone pieces 84" tall. The pergola as a whole is sold only with 84" columns. The beams do not come in different sizes. The colors are as shown and cannot be changed.

# What are the dimensions for the pergola?

- 98 ¼" high
- 171" wide
- 171" deep
- Columns 12 X 12 X 82 ¼"
- Top Beams 8 X 4 X 171"
- Support Beams 10 X 4 X 171"

#### How does it ship?

GRP-T-K1 Column 4ea/Ctn (1 Ctn/set)

GRP-T-K2 Top & Support Beams 7ea/Ctn (1 Ctn/set)

GRP-T-K3 Hardware 1ea/Ctn (1ctn/set)

## How much does each piece weigh?

- 82 ¼" Column = 135 lbs
- Top Beam = 110 lbs
- Support Beam = 130 lbs

# How long does it take to assemble?

With a minimum of two people, the pergola takes about an hour and a half to two hours to assemble. Assembly can be completed with standard tools.

## Can the pergola be set in concrete?

It can but it may void the warranty if done improperly. This item is not covered by "acts of God." In the event of a storm, even with the base secured, the top may still be destroyed.

#### What is the warranty?

3-year warranty on structure, 1-year warranty on finish
